Good news - superfast broadband is now available in some parts of **Wolvey**! Cabinet **Wolvey 5** has been upgraded, meaning that many properties connected to it can now order the improved service.

What should I do now?

1. Check that your property is connected to this cabinet and can get superfast speeds by going to www.dslchecker.bt.com and entering your landline number
2. Sign up with an Internet Service Provider for superfast services. Remember to check different providers for the best rates to meet your needs. Independent reviewers such as MoneySavingExpert.com or [Broadband Genie](http://BroadbandGenie) can provide information on cheap broadband deals.
