



NOTICE OF VACANCY TO BE FILLED BY CO-OPTION

WOLVEY PARISH COUNCIL

If you would you like to represent your local community and take part in decisions affecting where you live, why not apply to be co-opted onto Wolvey Parish Council?

To be a parish councillor, you must be at least 18 years old and be

- a British Citizen; or
- an eligible Commonwealth citizen; or
- a citizen of any other member state of the European Union

You must also meet at least **one** of the following four qualifications:

- you must be registered as a local government elector for the parish
- you must have occupied as owner or tenant, any land or premises in the parish during the whole of the preceding 12 months
- your principal or only place of work during the preceding twelve months has been in the parish
- you have during the whole of the preceding twelve months resided in the parish or within 3 miles of it
