

Reviewing the 2008 Wolvey Plan

A Wolvey Parish Plan was produced in 2008 and a great number of residents participated and gave assistance to produce the final document. This document has helped to direct the actions of the Parish Council over recent years and a significant number of the objectives stated in the Parish Plan have been achieved. It has also been instrumental in helping to access grants for the Council and organisations in Wolvey.

Planning for the Future

In planning for the future the Parish Council can make both long and short term plans.

Long Term Plans concentrate on the quality of life and shape of the village over the next 20 years.

The Government has recently introduced new procedures for long term planning at a local level - **The Neighbourhood Plan**. Information on what is involved in producing a **Neighbourhood Plan** will be displayed at the Drop-in-Day. Long term plans concentrate on the quality of life and shape of the village over the next 20 years. This is a formal procedure and the Parish Council is to consider if producing a **Neighbourhood Plan** will be of benefit to the village.

A Short Term Action Plan identifies those actions which can be carried out relatively quickly to improve life in the village.

The purpose of the Drop-in-Day on 10th May is for residents to let the Parish Council know the issues which are considered important to improve the quality of life in the village.

In the Millennium Building displays will show the possible actions that may be included in a short term plan. There will be an opportunity for your comments to be recorded and Parish Councillors will be on hand to give further information on the proposals.

When the Action Plan is agreed the progress will be monitored and reported at the monthly Parish Council meetings.
