

**WOLVEY PARISH COUNCIL**  
**Policy for posters on Wetland fence**

- 1) The Parish Clerk to be delegated to refuse applications from commercial organisations seeking to use Parish Council land for advertising. Applications from commercial organisations and the decisions to be notified to the Parish Council at the next available meeting .
- 2) Requests to promote village activities/events by advertising on Parish Council land will be reported to the Parish Council for consideration at the next available meeting. If permission granted notices should not be displayed for a period greater than 14 days before the event and notices must be removed within 3 days after the event.
- 3) Where an application to promote village activities / events is received which, because of time constraints, cannot be considered by the Parish Council then the Parish Clerk be delegated to decide the application and the decision reported to the next meeting of the Parish Council.
- 4) Requests by pressure groups/ organisation to promote their cause by displaying posters/ banners etc. should be reported to the Parish Council for consideration at the next available meeting. The Parish Council is to be notified of the content and style of the promotion. If the Parish Council agrees to permit signs to be displayed then a time limit will be notified to the Pressure Group / Organisation with the letter granting permission.
- 5) Notices displayed without permission will be removed immediately. The owner, if known, will be notified when and where these can be collected and if not collected will be disposed of after a period of 28 days.
