This years main project is to be the Play Area. With the help of the Parish Council we intend to purchase several items of new Play Equipment, The children at the School and also the village Beavers and Cubs have been voting for what they want. We are also looking at outdoor Adult Gym equipment (we would like some feedback about this from villagers). To facilitate this new equipment, several existing items will have to be moved.

How much support we get at our fund raising events has a huge effect on how often we can undertake such a project and also how large the project can be. So I look forward to seeing you all at the Bonfire, and if you have points to raise about how the field is run come to the AGM on 21st November – 7.30 at the Pavilion.

Our Committee is now only 10 strong, when I first joined it was over 20 strong, how times have changed, we need more volunteers to take the Field forward.
