Following on from the W.A.S.T.E. public meeting held at Wolvey Baptist Church on Friday 20th June, and the Wolvey Parish Council meeting held on Monday 21st July, we would like to take this opportunity to update you on some key activity in relation to the opposition of subsidised turbines around Wolvey:

- **[Deadline for Planning Objections to the Meteorological Mast - EXTENDED TO THURSDAY 31st JULY](#)**

As many Parish Councils in the area have not had the chance to hold a meeting to formulate their response to the meteorological mast application (R14/1106), on behalf of the parishioners they represent, Rugby Borough Council (RBC) have agreed to an extension to the process and comments can now be received up until Thursday 31st July.

Therefore, if you have forgotten to mention something in your first letter, or indeed if you haven't had enough time or indeed information to write your letter yet, there is still time to do this. - **[Wolvey Parish Council Meeting - Application OBJECTION](#)**

At the meeting on Monday 21st July 2014, Wolvey Parish Council voted to send a letter of OBJECTION to Rugby Borough Council in respect of the planning application for the meteorological mast. Planning consultant Neil Pearce has assisted the Parish Council in formulating their response. - **Rugby Borough Council are aiming to take this application to Planning Committee on 3rd September 2014, however this date will need to be confirmed by RBC much closer to the date and possibly not before the 22nd August. Please keep 3rd September free and visit our website for the latest updates on the Planning Committee date.**

Rugby Borough Council Planning Committee Members will make a decision regarding this application for a meteorological mast. Albeit our elected Councillors on the Planning Committee will be aware of how many objections have been received by Rugby Borough Council, we need to actually be there to fill the Town Hall Chamber and Gallery. Our hopeful mass attendance will clearly indicate to our elected borough council representatives just how strongly we object to this application. Our presence will also help ensure:-

- a) Requested conditions are clearly referred to by our Councillors and taken note of;
- b) These perfectly reasonable conditions are attached to any permission given.

We do hope you will join with us to show your support in person at the Planning Committee meeting. The press will be there to capture the extent of our opposition to this metrological mast application on the Town Hall steps at 5pm, before we go into the Council Chamber.
