WHEREAS the Warwickshire County Council ("the Council") as traffic authority for Warwickshire North is satisfied that traffic on the roads as indicated in the Schedule attached to this Order should be restricted and that the speed of traffic on the said roads should be restricted by virtue of works proposed to be executed thereon

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This order shall come into operation on 15 April 2019 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Surface Dressing 2019 - Warwickshire North) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019" and "The Warwickshire County Council (Surface Dressing 2019 - Speed Restrictions - Warwickshire North) (Temporary 10 mph Speed Limit) Order 2019"
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than an exempted vehicle to use the roads as indicated in the schedule attached to this Order for a period of 18 months commencing on 15 April 2019, or until the said works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the roads as indicated in the Schedule attached to this Order for a period of 18 months commencing on 15 April 2019, or until the aforesaid works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
4. In this Order exempted vehicle means any vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
5. The provisions of Article 2 and Article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs, as authorised by Section 64 of the said Act of 1984.

The closures are required to facilitate carriageway surface dressing works.

PLEASE NOTE: 10MPH Speed restrictions will be imposed for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working on the carriageway, whilst work for surface dressing is being carried out and for a short period thereafter – advance signage will be in place as appropriate.

The Order will commence on 15 April 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that all works will be completed on or before 30 September 2019.

Please Note: The date(s) of each closure will be indicated by advance signage that will be put in place as appropriate.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
